The 4-1 Jr. Raiders are on a Roll

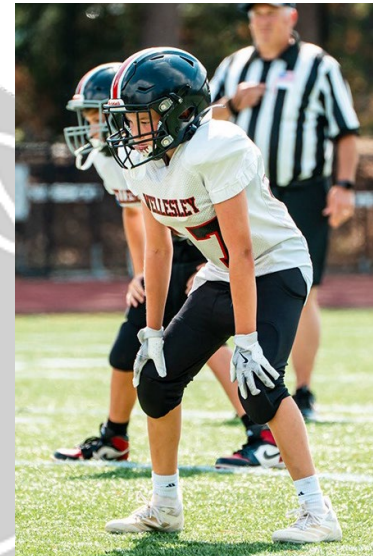
after beating Weymouth **34-0** on Sunday. The Raiders went up early and never looked back with long runs and an early score by Running Back [Mason Davies](#). Kicker [George Collard](#) continuing to provide the Raiders with 2-point advantages with his leg. [Luke Estwanik](#) continues to be a work horse in the power run game chipping away every time he carries the



football. [Chase Mock](#) and [Morgan Flynn](#) keep producing at halfback while Quarterback [Grayson Guigli](#) completed a number of passes on the day to Tight End [Graham Stone](#) and others - most notably sprinting out to connect with receiver [Jack Quinn](#) for a 20 yard

completion to convert a 3rd and long which set up Fullback [William Comella](#) to power his way down the middle of the field and into the endzone for a TD. Running Back [Bradley Cohn](#) ran tough all day, breaking tackles and

punching one into the endzone himself. [Mason Davies](#) putting the raiders up 28-0 with his 2nd TD of the day on a sweep to the left with an impressive lead block by pulling guard [Teddy Halloran](#). [Luke Harper](#) pulling in an athletic “pick 6” from the 50 yard line put the nail in the coffin in the 4th quarter as they sailed to victory.



Defensively the boys posted a shutout holding the Wildcats to very few yards on the ground. The defensive line was in the Wildcat backfield much of the afternoon while the secondary shut down Weymouth’s ability to pass the ball. Linebacker [Bradley Cohn](#) played relentless football inside shutting down all inside run. The Raiders have shown some improvement in their open field tackling and will continue to improve upon that in the coming weeks. It was great having cornerback [Tommy Sayles](#) back on the field

The 7th Grade Jr. Raiders

battled hard against Weymouth in a back-and-forth showdown, trading touchdowns all game long! [Schneider](#) aired it out, [Nardone](#) powered through on the ground, [Garrison](#) hauled in key catches, and [Miles](#) nailed the PATs. Great energy from the boys who showed up and played tough despite small numbers — and awesome to see [Bobby D](#) back in action! The Raiders look to finish strong over the next two weeks against Milton and Walpole.

The 8th Grade Jr. Raiders

were able to build on their big win against Quincy with a solid victory against a much improved Weymouth team. Despite having 10 of the original 22 starting positions out for the game, the Raiders executed well on both sides of the ball on their way to a 34-6 win.

Wellesley received the opening kick off and marched right down the field. After receiving the opening kick off, QB [Conor Cullinan](#) dropped back and hit [Levi Hirsh](#) in stride for a 34 yard gain. [Cullinan](#) then hit [Bryce MacInnes](#) for a 13 yard completion and another first down. [Cullinan](#) finished off a flawless first drive by Connecting with [Hirsh](#) a second time for a 14 yard touchdown. With long snapper [Charlie Donoghue](#) out with a foot injury, the Raiders went for the one point conversion. [Cullinan](#) hit [MacInnes](#) in the endzone for the conversion.

The defense had a difficult start to the game with an offside penalty and a missed assignment leading to a long Weymouth touchdown run. They tightened up on the conversion leading to a missed kick and a 7-6 lead. The defense would figure things out on

the next series and not give up another score until the clock was running at the end of the game.

The offense faltered on the next drive with the bright sun leading to a turnover, but as great teammates do, the defense immediately picked them up. [Levi Kashou](#) made a perfect form tackle to stop Weymouth for a short gain on first down. On second down [Bryce MacInnes](#) tackled the QB in the backfield for a 5 yard loss. On 3rd down, [Eric Jastromb](#), [Jack McCormick](#) and [Charlie Dube](#) attacked the running back, leaving him nowhere to go causing him to lose another 4-5 yards. On 4th and long, a swarm of tacklers stopped the Weymouth running back and gave the ball back to the offense.

With the ball back, [Cullinan](#) and the passing game went back to work, starting with 2 quick passes to [Nick Carlozzi](#) for a first down. Now on their third series, the Raiders have yet to run the ball, so when they ran toss to [Bryce MacInnes](#), Weymouth was not prepared. [MacInnes](#) got the corner and sprinted 56 yards to the endzone. [Cullinan](#) hit [Noah Hill](#) for the conversion and the Raiders led 14-6.

On their next series, Weymouth moved the ball a little bit, but solid tackling by [Tom Hiscox](#), [Watson Waller](#), and [John Creney](#) put them in a 4th and 6 situation. [Bryce MacInnes](#) came of

the edge with a tackle for a loss to give the offense the ball back.

The Raiders mixed the pass and the run, with [Cullinan](#) hitting [Levi Hirsh](#) for a 13-yard gain, followed by a [MacInnes](#) run for 44 yards to the Weymouth 25-yard line. [Cullinan](#) hit [Hirsh](#) again for another 10-yard gain, but it was called back for a penalty. [Cullinan](#) then dropped back and hit [MacInnes](#) down the sideline for a first down at the Weymouth 10-yard line. On the next play, [Cullinan](#) again hit [MacInnes](#) this time for a 10-yard score. The conversion pass fell incomplete and the Raider led 20-6.

The defense went back to work with two quick stops led by the defensive line. After [Noah Hill](#) made a touchdown saving tackle, [Charlie Dube](#) busted through the line and not only caused a fumble, but he also picked it up and returned it for another 20 yards.

After [Cullinan](#) connected with [MacInnes](#) for a 31 yard gain, Wellesley turned the ball over for a second time.

The defense responded with [Luke Duvall](#) almost intercepting a Weymouth pass on the first play. After [Watson Waller](#) made a great tackle, the defensive line flushed the Weymouth QB from the pocket. He threw downfield and after [John Creney](#) tipped the

ball, [Oliver Berg](#) intercepted it giving the offense another chance before halftime.

After being burned by the Raider's passing attack, Weymouth was now dropping 8 into coverage and only rushing 3. Under normal circumstances this would be a time to run the ball. However with roughly a minute left in the half, and only one timeout remaining, the Raiders has no choice but to throw the ball despite the challenge being presented. The Raiders moved the ball through the air with a variety of receivers contributing but ended the half with Weymouth breaking up a pass in the endzone.

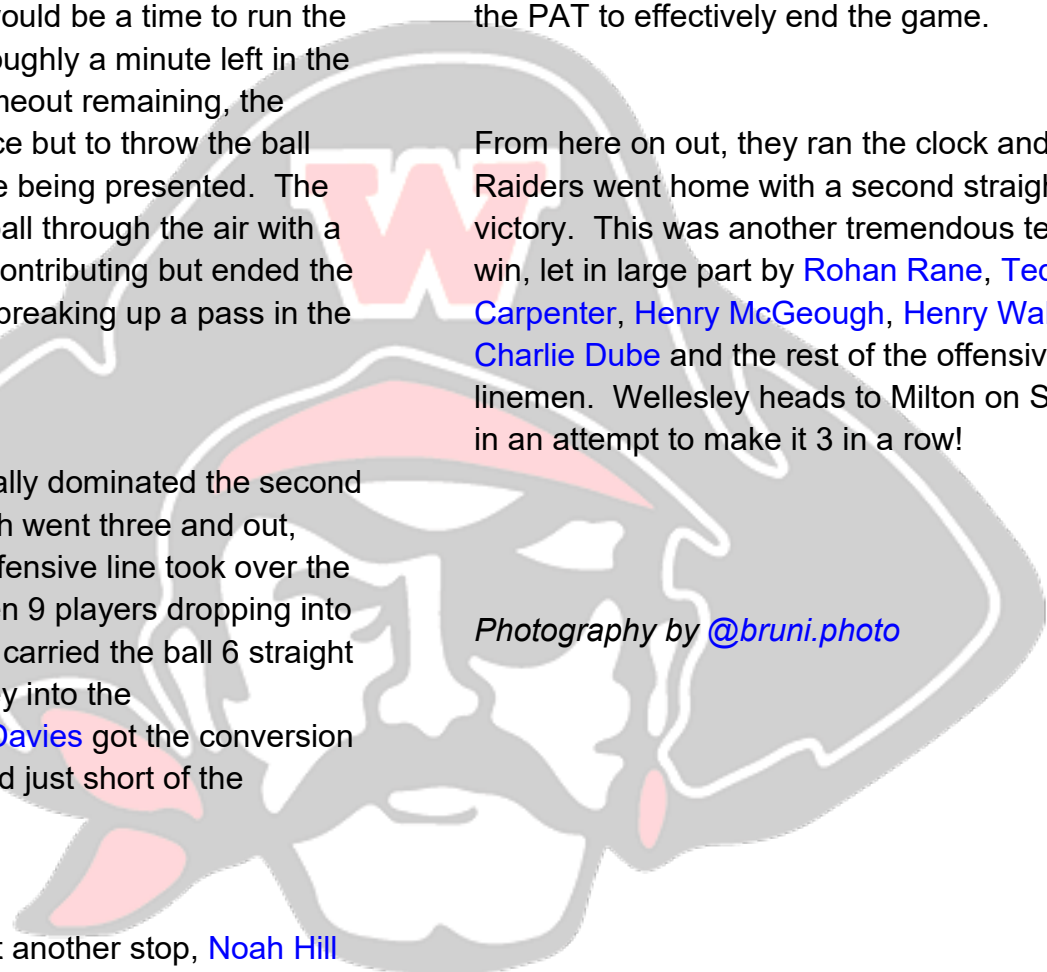
The Raiders essentially dominated the second half. After Weymouth went three and out, MacInnes and the offensive line took over the game. With 8 or even 9 players dropping into coverage, [MacInnes](#) carried the ball 6 straight times to get Wellesley into the endzone. [Harrison Davies](#) got the conversion pass but was stopped just short of the endzone.

After the defense got another stop, [Noah Hill](#) got his first carry of the season and took it almost 40 yards to the house thanks in large part to [Charlie Dube's](#) Police escort as his lead

blocker. Despite normal long snapper [Charlie Donoghue](#), being injured, the Raiders decided to kick for 2 points in order to increase the lead to 28 points and instituting the mercy rule. [Harrison Davies](#), snapping for the first time in a live situation, got a perfect snap back to holder [Conor Cullinan](#), and [MacInnes](#) kicked the PAT to effectively end the game.

From here on out, they ran the clock and the Raiders went home with a second straight victory. This was another tremendous team win, let in large part by [Rohan Rane](#), [Teddy Carpenter](#), [Henry McGeough](#), [Henry Waller](#), [Charlie Dube](#) and the rest of the offensive linemen. Wellesley heads to Milton on Sunday in an attempt to make it 3 in a row!
